We are responding to your correspondence requesting relief for a late S corporation election, for an effective date of September 4, 2002. Based on the information submitted, and your Internal Revenue Service account, it appears that automatic relief under section 4.03(1) of Revenue Procedure 2003-43 applies to your situation. Therefore, we have asked the Cincinnati Service Center staff to update your account to reflect the requested S corporation effective date. If you fail to receive an acceptance letter from the Service Center within the next 60 days, please call the listed contact person.

In addition, the IRS has developed two new CD-ROMs to help educate small business owners on their tax responsibilities: (1) Introduction to Federal Taxes for Small Business/Self-Employed; and (2) A Virtual Small Business Workshop.
